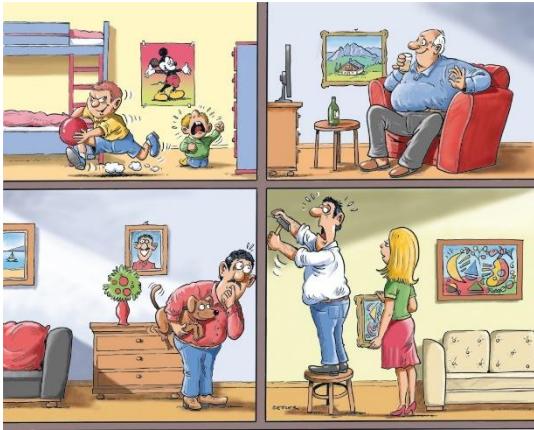

Therefore, please be especially considerate - above all, playing children need our tolerance at the moment. Try to avoid noise-generating activities yourself. The rest times in your house rules still apply.
